IF YOU HAVE AN AKC SIBERIAN, MALAMUTE OR SAMOYED THAT IS ALTERED **OR** HAVE WHAT APPEARS TO BE A SIBERIAN. MALAMUTE OR SAMOYED SIGN THEM UP FOR SPAY/NEUTER CONFIRMATION.

**ANY** DOG CAN BE SIGNED UP FOR SLED DOG. ALTERED OR NOT, PUREBRED OR NOT THEY ARE JUDGED ON WHAT THEIR STRUCTURE IS FOR.

IF YOU HAVE A CHILD THAT WANTS TO TRY THEIR HAND AT HANDLING A SHOW DOG, SIGN THEM UP FOR JUNIOR HANDLING. THEY CAN USE AN BREED DOG, JUST HAS TO BE ONE THAT THEY CAN WALK THEMSELVES. A WONDERFUL JUDGE WILL HELP THEM UNDERSTAND WHAT IT TAKES TO "SHOW A DOG" IT IS FUN AND EVERYONE GETS A RIBBON.
