There is room for tie-outs where we sled from but not in the parking lot.

The last two months we have done Sunday morning runs. It has had an overwhelming attendance of those that don't like to camp but want to try to run their dogs. We run the dogs and have breakfast between runs. People and the dogs have enjoyed the experience.

We are currently working on the logistics of doing this a little more but probably on a basis of reservations. Ultimately the safety of the dogs is foremost and we want to keep that. We can't always run all the dogs that have attended. This is a work in progress.

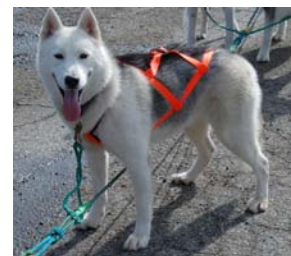
Go to SNDD.org to get more information on the races. This year they may get postponed because of the current lack of snow....time will tell.

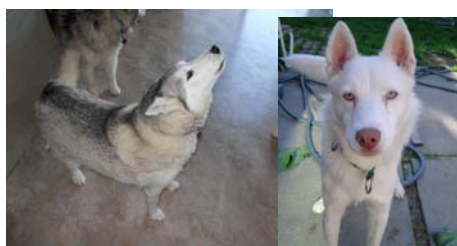
