



**When:** June 23 & 24th

**What to bring:** dogs, jackets, sleeping bag, tent.....

Please note that we must pass through 3 locked gates. You can not be late.

Groups must stay together on the way out until reaching Camden or the Expressway



We meet at the gate at 5pm (or call Randee and you can meet at her office at 4pm). Get up to the top and set up for dinner by 7 pm. If it is cool enough we might run before dinner, but not likely. We set up tents and other areas for those staying over night. We set up lines and are ready to go when and if it is cool enough.

In the morning we rise with the sun, harness them up again and run them about 4 miles. After running we have a GREAT breakfast. We
