All of those that look purebred Siberian, Malamute or Samoyed that have been rescued or acquired without papers but have been altered, can enter Conformation Spay/neuter for that breed.

Sled Dog- Sib, Sammy, Mal, and all those in between can enter Sled Dog. All of those that have taken our wonderful mixes....enter Sled Dog

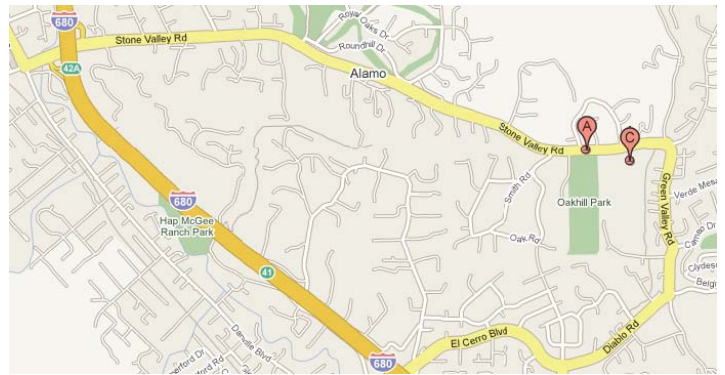
There are classes for puppies, adults, veterans and champions. We will be happy to help you with which to enter..

Traveling North on I-680 you would need to exit at Stone Valley East and turn right at the stop sign. The park will be on your right hand side about 1.5 miles down the road.

Traveling South on I-680 you would need to take the Stone Valley Road EAST exit. The park will be on your right hand side about 1.5 miles down the road.

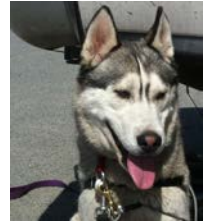

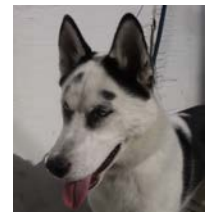

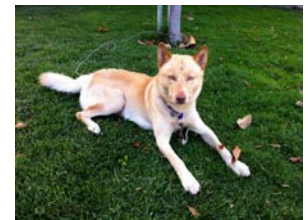

Harry has not had any basic training but is smart and food motivated, he will be easy to train. He does not pull when walking on a leash. He is fine with all sizes of dogs. I do not know about cats. He is good with children but is mouthy.
