At the meeting we will recap events and talk about upcoming ones. The Northern Breed Fun Match is in June and we hope to camp and cart again this summer.

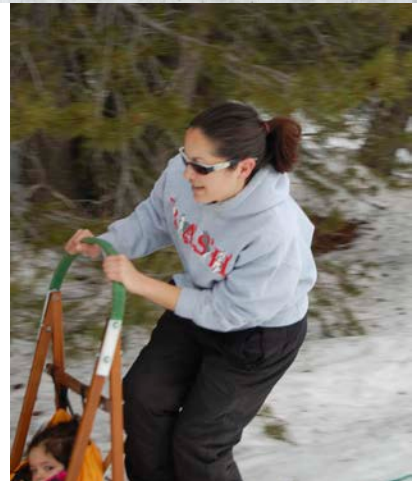
If interested, we are going to have a discussion of Sledding. At the last SnoBASH there were many that needed a reminder of terms and how we use them sledding.

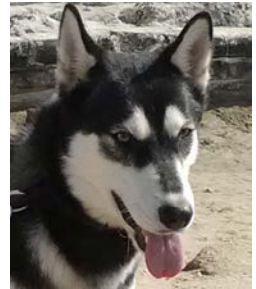
