Ever fantasized about running the Iditarod behind your own 16-dog team? Thought about how you would find the trail when you are out there in the wilderness by yourself? Worried about how you would go to the bathroom? Karen Ramstead, the first Canadian woman to complete the Iditarod, will be talking about her personal experiences in running this race multiple times. She will talk about training, showing and more.

Karen owns North Wapiti Kennels in Alberta, Canada, where she breeds and trains her dogs. They are beautiful purebred Siberians, hence the name "pretty sled dogs". Many of her racing dogs are champion show dogs also.

She will have a fantastic slide show with pictures taken during and after the running of the race which show the teams running along flawlessly while the musher stands on the runners looking at ease. Sled Dog- Sib, Sammy, Mal, and all those in between can enter Sled Dog. All of those that have taken our wonderful mixes....enter Sled Dog

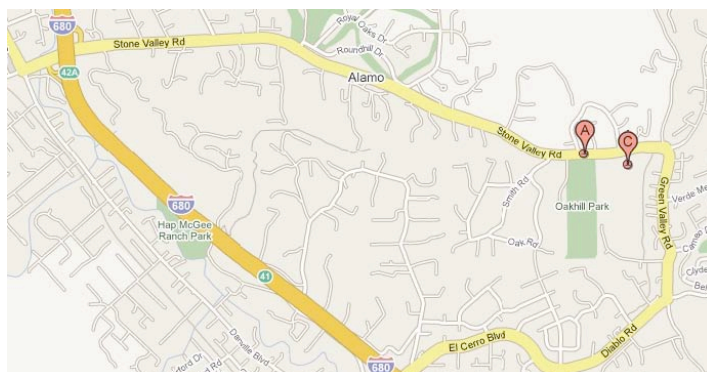
There are classes for puppies, adults, veterans and champions. We will be happy to help you with which to enter..

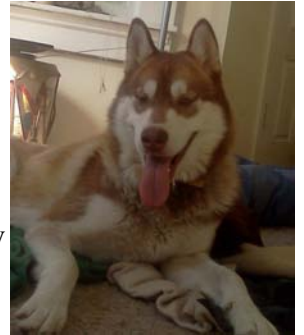
