During a recent outing when t he adults are talking I was such a good girl and just played with my toy laying down while they talked. I love being around other dogs and my favorite thing is to play! I get along with lots of doggie friends and I also love people!! Every time I meet someone, If they want to say hello to me, I

say hello back with kisses. True to my name, my absolute favorite entertainment is playing with water and swimming! just keep swimming, just keep swimming, swimming swimming.....

QUICK & EASY PEANUT BUTTER DOG TREATS

Ingredients

- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 2 eggs
- 1/4 cup water





- Preheat your oven to 350 F.
- Mix together your flour, peanut butter & eggs in a large bowl until slightly combined.
- Add in a little bit of water (approx. one Tbsp) at a time until the mixture is wet enough to roll out as dough.
- Roll out your dough & cut out your favorite shapes with some cookie cutters.
- Place your treats onto your baking sheet & cook in preheated oven for 15 minutes.
