CLASSES OFFERED (all dog classes divided by sex):

Regular Classes

- **Puppies**: 3-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months (winners of puppy classes do not compete with winners of adult classes)
- Adults: 12-18 months, Novice, Bred-by-Exhibitor, American- Bred, Open

Non Regular Classes

- Veteran for dogs/bitches 7+ years of age
- Sled Dog for dogs/bitches 12+ months of age
- Neuter/Spay for neutered males/spayed females
- Brace for two dogs with a common owner
- Team for four dogs with a common owner

Junior Showmanship

- Novice for boys/girls 8 to 16 years who have never won first place in Novice
- Open for boys/girls 8 to 16 years who have won first place in Novice

Parade of Rescue Siberians: To applaud those who have given home to homeless Siberian Huskies, the Northern California Siberian Husky Club welcomes you to our Parade of Rescued Siberian Huskies. To be eligible for entry, the dog must have been rescued. Each entrant will receive a memento as our thanks for giving a Siberian Husky a good home. To enter, complete the entry form as best you can.

Additional Rules:

This match will be run according to the American Kennel Club rules and regulations. Wins at sanctioned matches carry no American Kennel Club championship points.

Champions and dogs with major points may be shown only in Junior Showmanship or Non-Regular Classes.

No un-enterable dogs are allowed on the match grounds.

Licensed or professional handlers may only show dogs owned by them or by members of their immediate family.

Please follow your veterinarian's recommendations for your dogs to be free of parasites & communicable diseases, and to have necessary vaccinations.

No stake-out or drop lines attached to trees are allowed. Please clean-up after your own dog.
