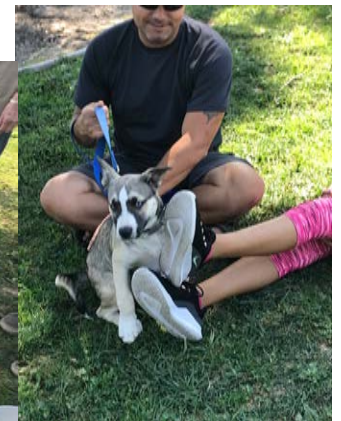

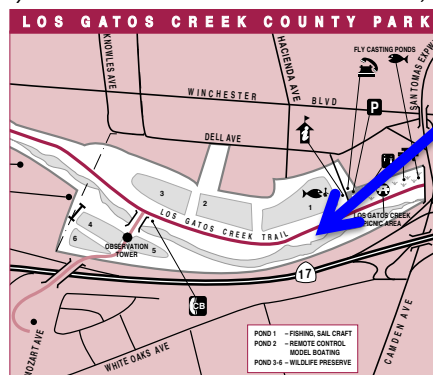

(GPS address is the firehouse next to the park- 34988 Eastin Dr, Union City 94587

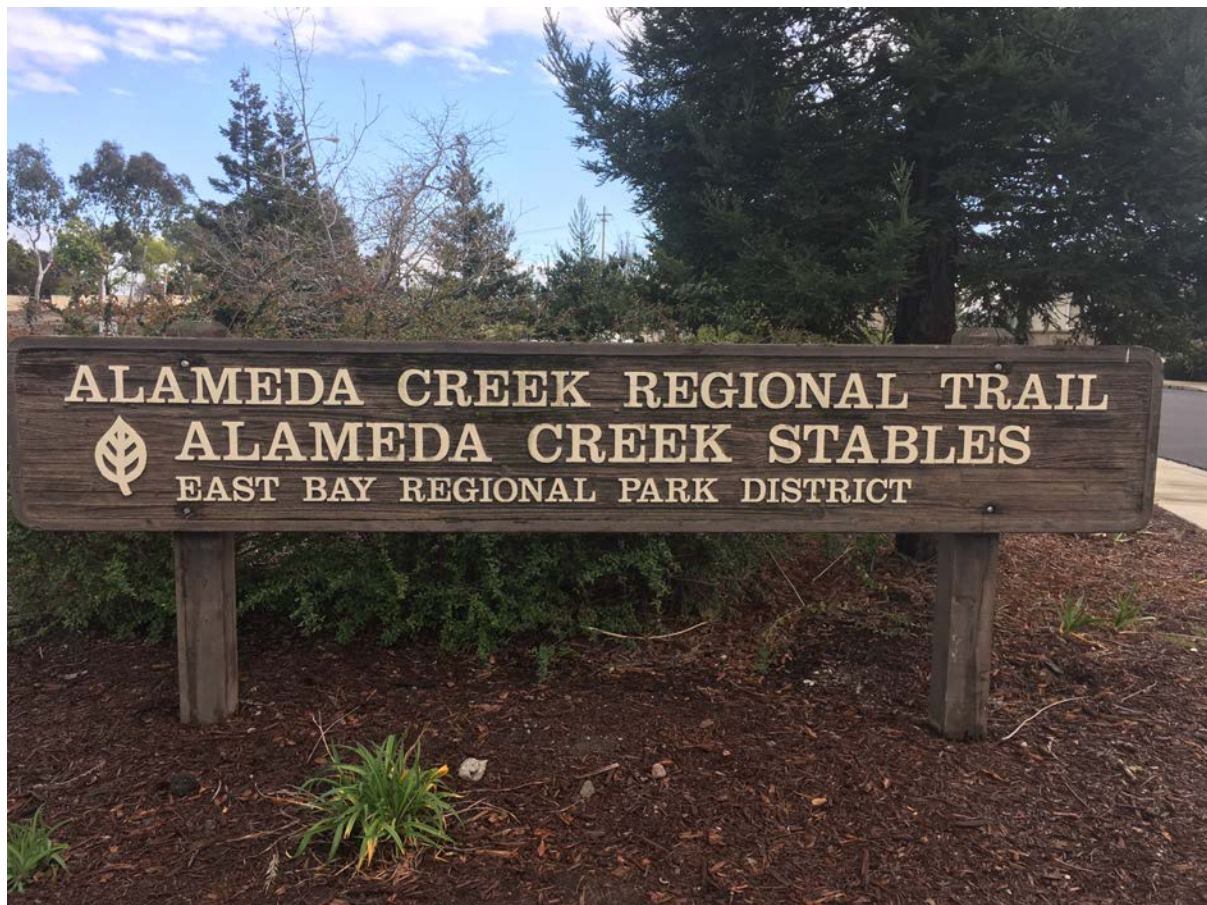

- If you have a scooter or cart to bring- please let us know.
- Bring a bike so someone can bike along with the group.
- MUST BRING A HELMUT to wear while scootering
- Two dogs per adult limit. (for control on scooters)

This event is to expose you and your dog to scootering and/or carting. We will be running 3 miles only of the trails available. We will have some drops set up to put your dog on safely while you learn and help others.

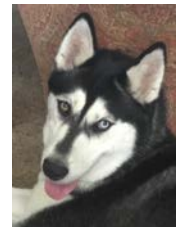

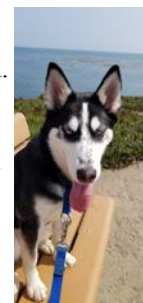

Ingredients

- 1 cup non-fat plain frozen yogurt
- 1/2 cup canned pure pumpkin
- 1/4 cup water

Time Required

15 minutes + freeze time

Cost and Tools Required

This project cost me \$1! I already had the ingredients and bought the [pumpkin ice cube tray](#) at the Dollar Tree.

Step One

Mix the yogurt, pumpkin, and water together. You can add more water to help make the mixture "runny" so that it's easier to fill the ice cube tray.

Step Two

Pour the mixture into your [pumpkin shaped ice cube tray \(s\)](#).

Step Three

Freeze for about 3-4 hours or overnight.

Once the treats are completely frozen, pop them out and serve! Happy [Howl-O-Ween!](#)
