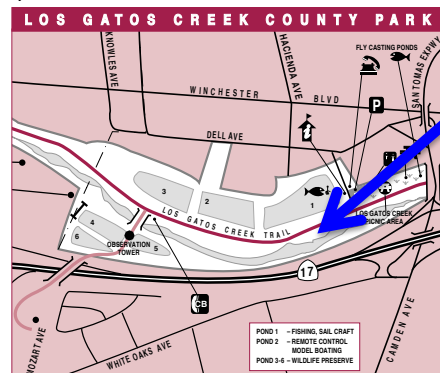

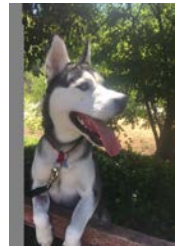

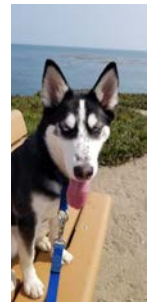

## Super Simple Sweet Potato Treats

### Ingredients:

- 1 sweet potato
- 2 ½ cups whole wheat flour
- ¼ cup unsweetened applesauce
- 2 eggs

### Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C)
2. Heat sweet potato in a microwave for ~6 minutes, checking every two minutes to see if tender.
3. Cut potato in half and remove the meat. Toss the skin.
4. Mash the meat in a bowl until soft.
5. In another bowl, mix eggs, applesauce, flour, and one cup of mashed sweet potato.
6. Roll out dough on a well floured surface until ½ inch thick. Then cut into strips, cubes, or use a cookie cutter to make fun shapes!
7. Place on a baking sheet and put into preheated oven.
8. Bake until crispy (35-40 minutes). Take out and let cool on wire rack before eating.
